Barge Policies

- ***Barging must be paid in full when the reservation is made***
- **Small Freight includes:** motor scooter, snow blower, rototiller, moped, kayak, windsurfer, canoe
- **Medium Freight includes:** motorcycle, lawn tractor/riding mower, ATV, golf cart
- Length of vehicle includes the tailgate (if down), cargo on vehicle extending beyond the tailgate and the tongue on trailers.
- Trailers and vehicles may have freight but vehicles/trailers over 25,000 pounds may receive a surcharge of \$50.00 at the Barge Captain's discretion.
- Barging to Yankee Marina is subject to a trip surcharge of \$315.00 one-way, Monday – Friday, and \$420.00 one-way on Saturday, Sunday, and holidays. Additionally, each vehicle will be charged a \$50.00 surcharge assessed to CTC by Yankee Marina.
- One driver per vehicle may ride the barge at no additional cost. Additional passengers are allowed on a ***space available basis***, not to exceed a total of ***six drivers and passengers*** per barge trip.
- Vehicles should be at the barge site a minimum of 15 minutes prior to departure.
- Cancellations received less than 24 hours prior to departure are subject to a cancellation fee of ½ the cost of their barge trip.
- Each customer is required to sign a Barge Services Agreement once annually.
- Customers must load and unload their deck freight.
- Unattended vehicles staged for barging must have the customer's name and "BARGE" clearly displayed on the windshield.
- **The Barge Captain, at his/her discretion, may assist with loading, or unloading, of vehicles and/or equipment. At no time are Barge Captains to be expected to load or unload large equipment, vehicles with trailers or other larger than normal vehicles or equipment.**
